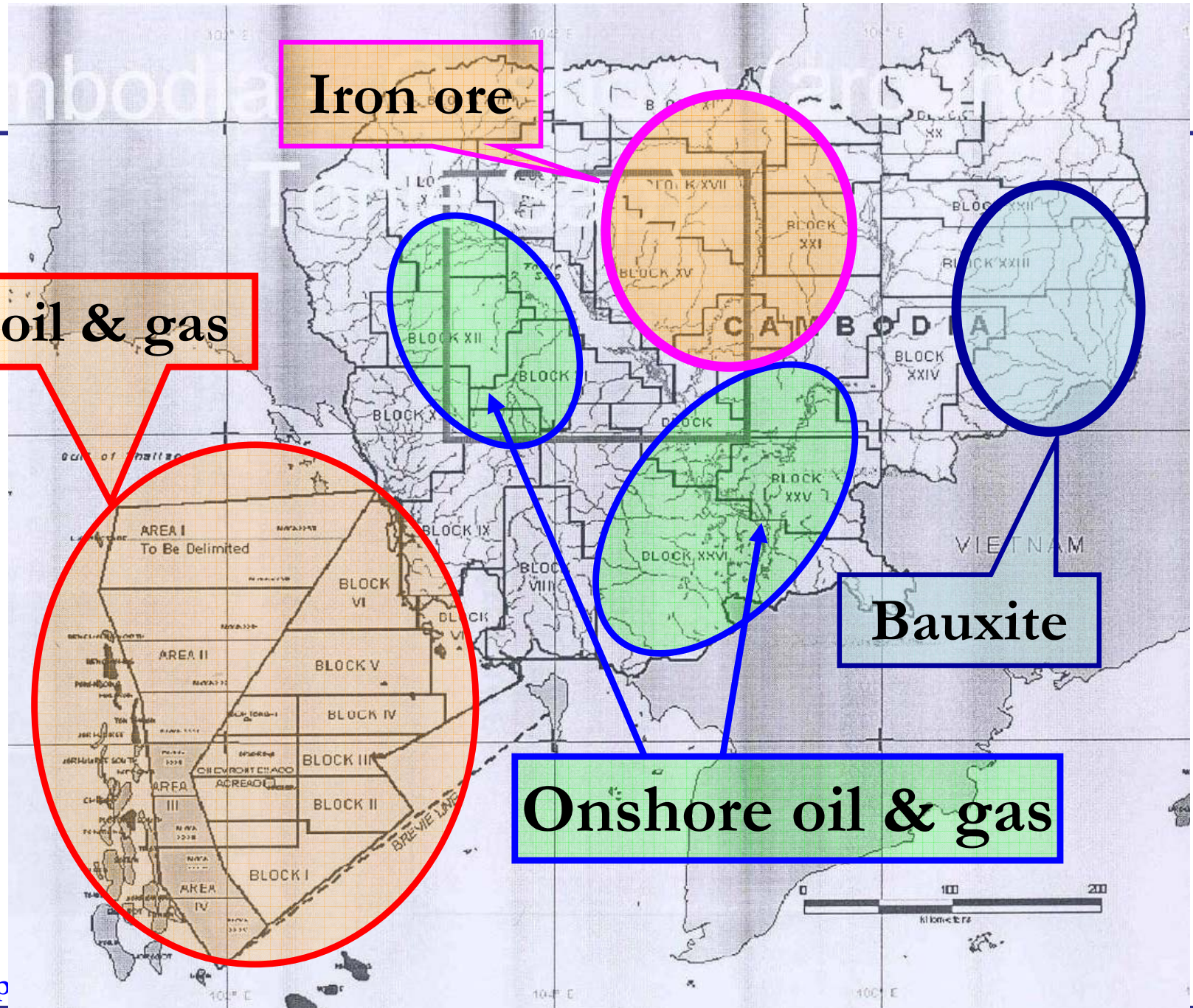

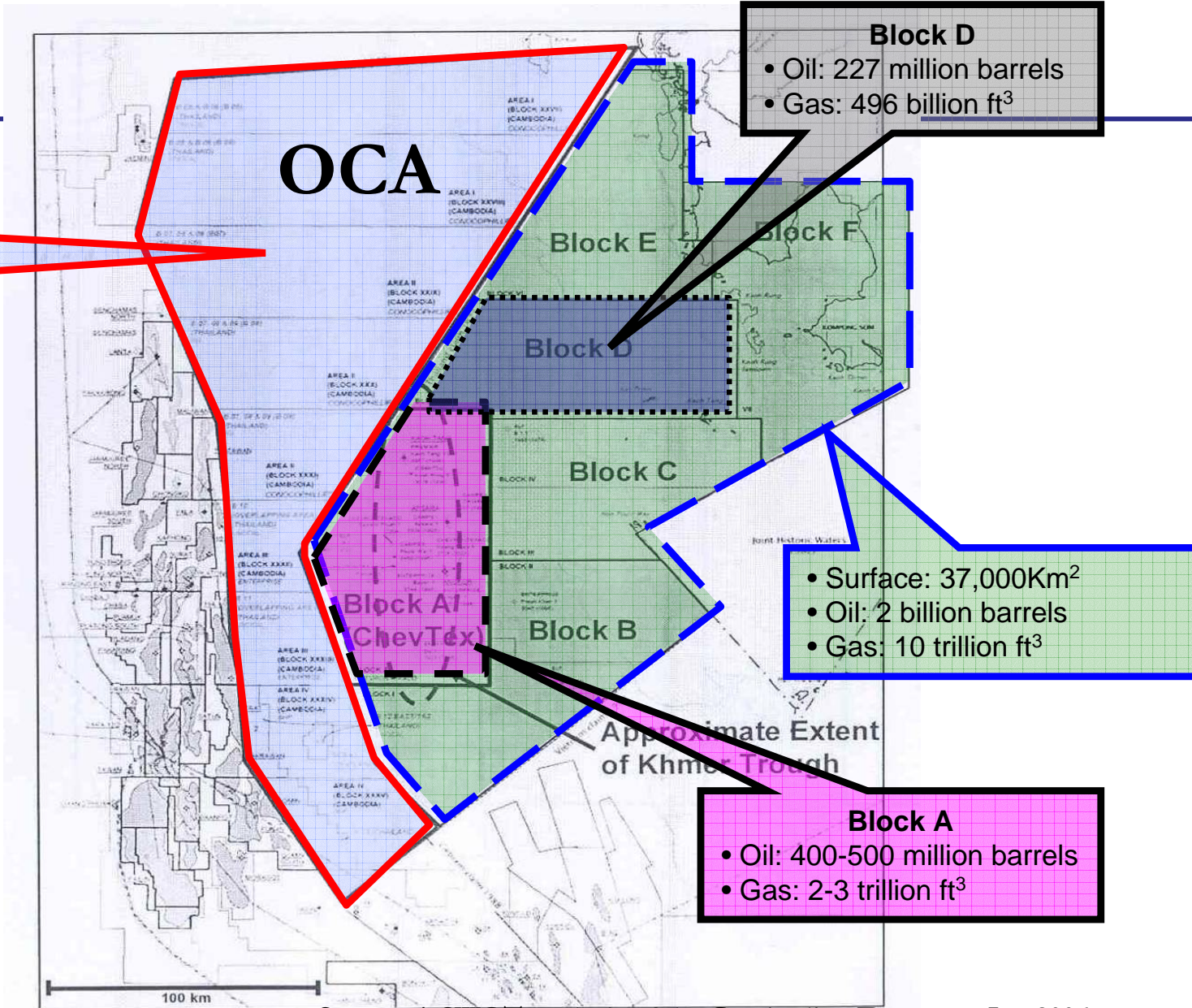
# Potential Offshore Oil & Gas Reserve

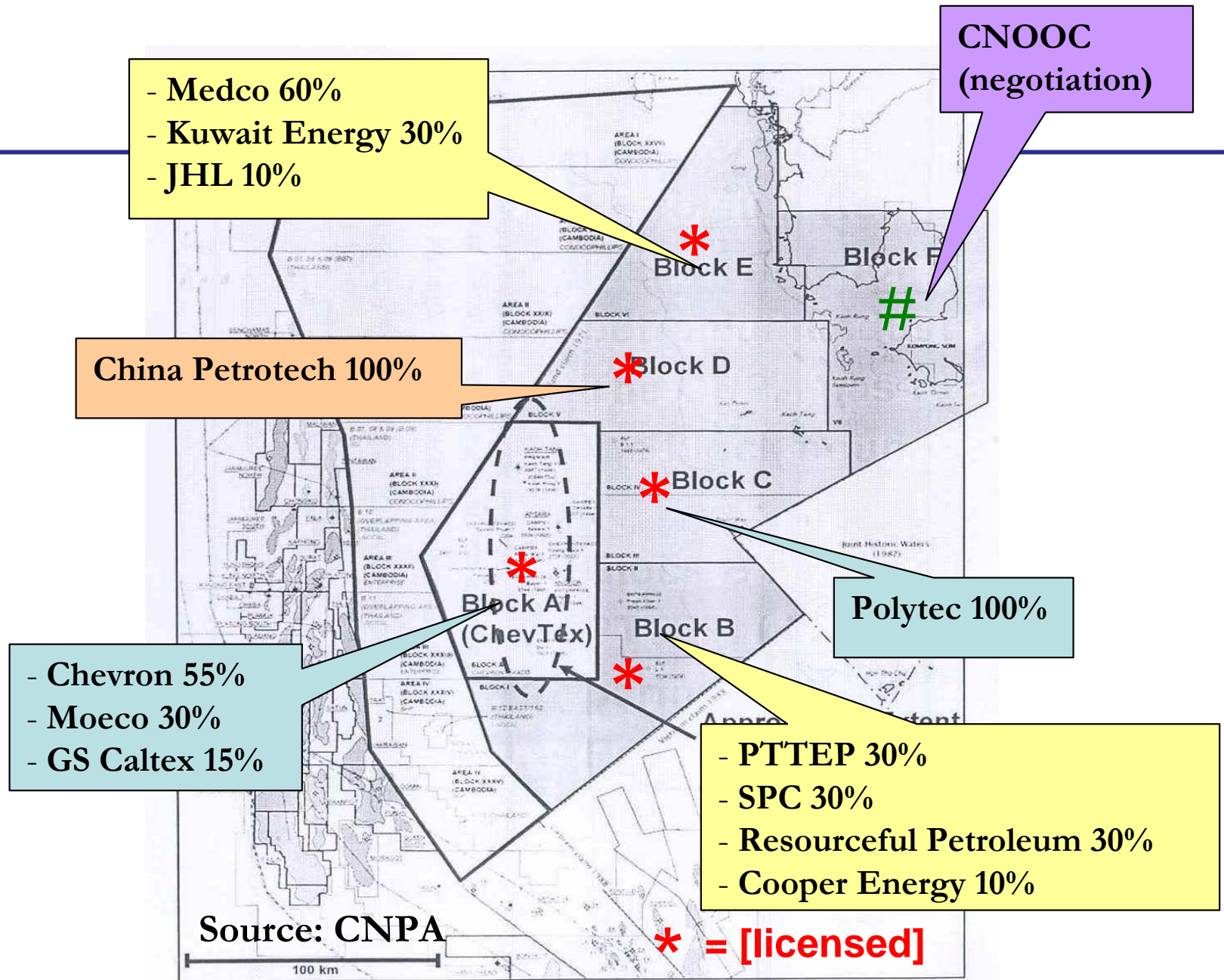
**Overlapping Claims Area**

- Surface: 27,000Km<sup>2</sup>
- Oil: 3 billion barrels

# Offshore Block Status



# Potential offshore Oil and Gas revenue

If ALL can be extracted...

- Estimated annual government revenue from all offshore blocks: **US\$ 3-4 billion** (~50% of GDP 2006).
- Annual revenue per capita: **US\$ 235** (GDP/capita 2006 = US\$510)

**Main assumption:**

- Crude oil price = US\$50/barrel
- Gas price = US\$0.005/ft<sup>3</sup>
- Government revenue from oil & gas (royalty + tax + other) = 50% of total sales
- Production period = 20 years

# Potential Offshore Oil and Gas revenue (cont.)

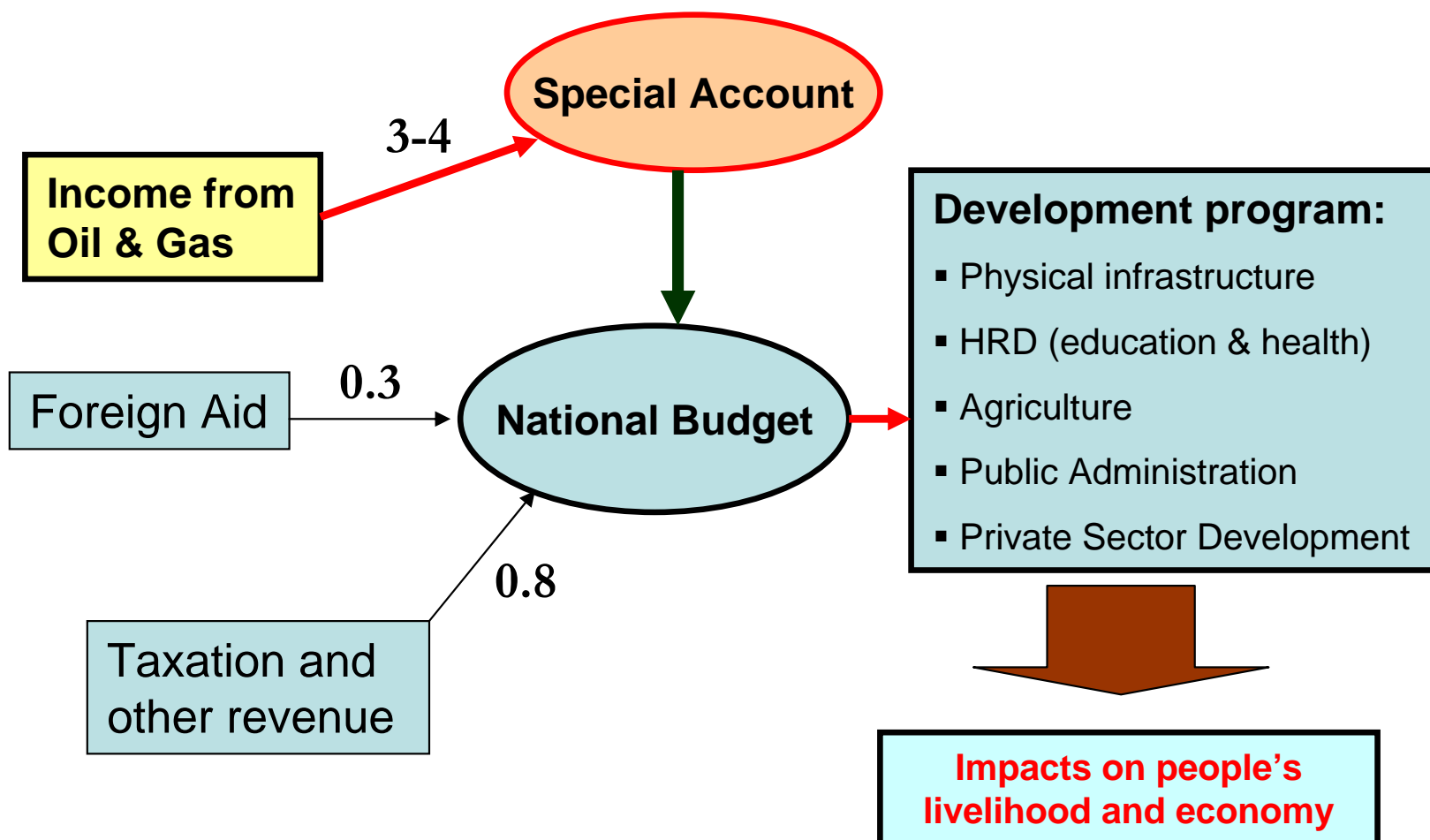
- Estimated government annual revenue of Block A + D: **US\$1-1.3 billion** (more than national budget in 2006)

So, if well managed...

***“oil & gas is an opportunity for sustaining growth and fostering development of Cambodia”***
